Dear Parents,

As part of Children's Mental Health Week, the children did lots of mindfulness activities. We talked about what makes us happy and all of the children said that their mummy and daddy make them happy because they love them!

We also listened to and joined in with singing 'The Feelings Song' by Miss Molly.

The children enjoyed joining in when we read the story 'We're Going On a Bear Hunt' in the Nursery this week. They had fun thinking of other animals that could have been in the cave at the end of the story! Next week, we will continue to complete activities based on 'We're Going On a Bear Hunt.' We will be using different resources such as material, tissue, glitter and paint to make a map of the route that the family in the story take when they are on their bear hunt. We will also be making sandwiches and having a teddy bear's picnic in the Nursery on Wednesday 12th February. The children can bring their own bear or soft toy in on Wednesday.

We count to different amounts every day in the Nursery. We are also learning to recognise numbers up to at least 5 and beyond. As you are aware, we teach the children one letter name and sound in the Nursery each week.
