Dear Parents,

We have been busy painting our self-portraits and learning about the different parts of a body in the Nursery this week. The children have also been drawing pictures of themselves and using words such as eyes, nose, mouth, lips, eye brows and hair to describe the features of their face.

Over the next couple of weeks, the children will be using water colour paints to paint pictures of themselves. We will be talking about different parts of the body and using language such as arms, legs, hands, feet, fingers, toes etc. The children will also be making props for the Christmas concert on Friday 13th December.

We will be practising singing songs for our Christmas concert. Next week, you will receive a copy of the song words. **Please help your child to learn the words at home.**



Suitable Clothing

As the weather is getting colder, please make sure that you dress your child in appropriate and comfortable clothing. Some children are coming to school without a coat. We provide opportunities for children to learn outside in all weathers, so it is important that they come to school with a coat every day, especially during the winter months. It is also important that you dress your children in comfortable clothing that they can manage independently, especially when using the toilet.

- To follow simple instructions.

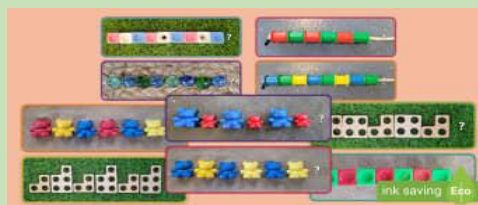
Literacy:
