This week, the children have been making 'information sheets' for our new Reception teachers so that they can begin to get to know a little bit about them. The children have drawn pictures of the activities that they like to do in the Nursery.

We will be making a book using the information sheets made by the children for each of the 4 Reception teachers. The children will be able to look at their class books throughout the year when they are in their new Reception class.



Home Learning: 15th – 19th July 2024

Next week, we are learning:

Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

- To talk about how we feel about finishing our Nursery year and going to our Reception class in September. At home, please talk to your child about moving from Nursery to Reception in order to prepare them for this change.
- To adapt behaviour to different social situations and changes in routine.

Physical Development:

- To hold a pencil with a comfortable grip and use it with good control. Many of the children are now forming the letters in their name beautifully. At home, please help your child to form the letters in their name correctly.

Communication & Language:

- To respond to simple instructions.

Literacy:

- We will be revising all of the letter names and sounds of the alphabet. Your child can practise singing all of the Jolly Phonics songs at home on YouTube. Here is a link:

- To count up to at least 10 in sequence.
